

Help ensure that properties are included on the respective Member's statement of values and that each property has sufficient coverage for replacement. Safety Benefits Inc., (SBI) encourages SDPAA Members to take an active role in risk management and supports them in these efforts.

Loss control surveys are conducted with SDPAA Members every three years to assist Members in reducing potential liability exposures.

Property valuations are done every five years to help Members determine adequate values for property covered by SDPAA.

Managing risks and controlling losses can reduce, and in some cases eliminate, liability. Members taking an active role in reducing exposure to civil liability may earn recognition awards.


Two free hotlines are available for Members with questions concerning employment practices and/or civil legal issues. The hotlines are sponsored by SDPAA and coordinated by SBI.




MEMBERSHIP INVESTMENTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS, PAST 25 YEARS
